ORDER:

In the reference second read above, the minutes of the Third Steering Committee Meeting held on 22.12.2015 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government were communicated, wherein, the project proposal of J-PAL for "Improving School Preparedness and Child Health Outcomes through ICDS" has been approved. It was also indicated that the budget for the proposal would be presented to the State Planning Commission as a Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) for funding.

2. In the reference third read above, the State Planning Commission has reported that it has appraised the proposal of "Improving School Preparedness and Child Health Outcomes through ICDS" and recommended the project at a cost of Rs.956.57 lakhs for a period of 3 years (Rs.191.314 lakhs + Rs.430.45 lakhs Rs.334.80 lakhs) under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives. Of this, Rs.542.00 lakhs is to be the evaluation cost to be released to M/s. J-PAL and Rs.414.57 lakhs the intervention cost to be incurred by ICDS. A sum of Rs.191.314 lakhs has been recommended by State Planning Commission for the year 2015-2016. The project aims to study the nutrition and pre-school education practices in 700 Anganwadi centers spread across selected districts in Tamil Nadu. The study identified five key interventions in nutrition, early childhood education and human resource organization that have the potential to improve the quality of services provided at Anganwadi centers. The project is expected to start from January 2016 and will go on till December 2018. The J-PAL portion of the cost will be Rs.87.03 lakhs to be incurred on the Principal Investigator staff time, travel etc.

3. The Government after careful consideration approve the project "Improving School Preparedness and Child Health Outcomes through ICDS" at a cost of Rs.956.57 lakhs for three years under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Scheme (Part-II Scheme), of this the Government of Tamil Nadu share of the study cost to be released to J-PAL will be Rs.542.00 lakhs and Rs.414.57 lakhs will be released to Integrated Child Development Services Scheme towards intervention cost. The Government further orders the release of a sum of Rs.1,91,32,000/- (Rupees One crore ninety one lakhs and thirty two thousand only) for the year 2015-2016 under the scheme of Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives towards 20% share to J-PAL. Project funding Milestones /Deliverable against which funding may be released to M/s. Institute for Financial Management and Research who will receive the grant on behalf of Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab – South Asia (J-PAL –SA), are indicated below:-

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

J-PAL South Asia

1. Design each of the interventions (with support from the government) being evaluated in the RCT.
2. Design the research study (Sampling and survey instruments).
3. Develop protocols for primary data collection.
4. Conduct baseline, midline and end line surveys.
5. Conduct regular monitoring of treatment and control groups.
6. Hire and train field staff which would include the Research Associate, Project Associate and surveyors to carry out the RCT.
7. Analyze the primary data collected from the baseline, midline and end line surveys.
8. Communicate regularly with the government on progress of the study and submit a final report/presentation to share results of the study.

Department of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS)

1. Designate a point person who will play a hands-on role for the project's success, e.g., provide relevant data, connect the J-PAL team to other GoTN officials, and give feedback during pilot. We propose that the Department designate Dr B. Shanthi (Deputy Director, Health, ICDS) as our primary point person from the Department.
2. Assist J-PAL staff in designing the interventions, and working with ICDS staff in study districts to implement the interventions in the randomly-chosen centers.
3. Assist J-PAL staff in designing the research study, i.e., provide inputs on district selection and survey instruments.
4. Providing permission to introduce interventions and conduct surveys.
5. Provide access to information and materials relating to recruitment, training, remuneration, health, nutrition and pre-schooling.
6. Adhere to the protocols for conducting the Randomized Control Trial (RCT).
