ORDER:

In the G.O first read above, Orders have been issued for the establishment of "Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII)" in the State Planning Commission to promote Innovation in Government and Government Agencies. Accordingly, a "State Innovation Fund" has been setup by restructuring the existing part – II schemes (new schemes) from the financial year 2015-16 with an initial corpus of Rs.150 crores. Initially TANII would work within Government and Government agencies address processes and problems to foster Innovation through a variety of promotional activities and funding support to innovative ideas, schemes and programmes.

2. In the G.O. second read above, orders were issued publishing the Guidelines for Identification and Implementation of Innovative Schemes.

3. As per the norms prescribed in the above G.O's, Government have forwarded the proposals received from the Director General, Highways Department in the letter fourth read above to the State Planning Commission for its approval at an estimated cost of Rs. 16.27 Crore under State Innovation Fund for the year 2015 - 16.

4. The Member Secretary, State Planning Commission in his letter fifth read above has stated that after detailed discussion; the State Planning Commission has

recommended two proposals for implementation out of fifteen proposals forwaged by the Government as detailed below:-
