ORDER:-

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden has sent the proposal in the references first and third read above for "Development of water management strategy in Point Calimere Wildlife Sanctuary" and requested the Government to sanction an amount of Rs.27.50 lakh under TANII - State Innovation Fund for the year 2018-2019 (Round-I).

2. In the letter second read above the State Planning Commission has recommended this scheme excluding cost on purchase of vehicle and Driver. Accordingly, the arrived cost of assistance under TANII is Rs.27.50 lakh as follows:-

3. The Hon'ble Minister (Forests) has made the following announcement on the floor of Assembly on 29.05.2018:-

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.27.50 lakh (Rupees Twenty seven lakh and fifty thousand only) under TANII - State Innovation Fund during the year 2018-2019 (Round-I), as annexure-I & II to this order.

5. (i). The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2402-00 SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION – 102 Soil conservation, State's Expenditure, KB Development of Water Management Strategy in Point Calimere Wildlife Sanctuary under State Innovation Fund – 09 Grants-in- Aid-03 Grants for Specific Schemes

(DPC – 2402 00 102 KB 0931)”

(ii). the expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

“2402 – 00 SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION – 902 – Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund. State's Expenditure – JA Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund. 30 Inter-Account Transfers

(DCP – 2402 00 902 JA 3006)”

And Contra – debiting the following fund account:-

“J – Reserve Fund – (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest – 8229 – 00 – Development Welfare Funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund

(DPC – 8229 00 200 BE 0006) (Outgo)

6. Necessary funds are provided in the Budget Estimates 2018-2019.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above. He is also requested to ensure that the amount released therein is utilized in full and to send the utilization certificate as soon as the work is completed.
