ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission has invited new Innovative Proposals, to be eligible for funding under the State Innovation Fund, which fulfills the eligibility criteria and adheres to the guideliness permitted under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII).

2. The Director/ Generation, TANGEDCO in the letter received 2nd read above has submitted the proposal titled "Comprehensive condition monitoring techniques for lightning arresters of EHV/ HV substations using Third harmonic leakage current measurement, Infra Red Thermography in live conditions and off line HV watt loss test" which fulfils the eligibility criteria and adheres to the

guidelines prescribed under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) directly to Member Secretary, State Planning Commission.

3. In the letter third read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission has stated that the State Planning Commission has appraised one proposal received from Energy Department and the recommendation is as follows:-

Comprehensive condition monitoring techniques for lighting arresters of EHV/HV substations using Third harmonic leakage current measurement, Infra Red Thermography in live conditions and off line HV watt loss test

The TANGEDCO proposed this comprehensive diagnostic and evaluation method of lighting arresters to avoid/protect the equipment from failure due to overvoltage, by monitoring the condition of the lightning arresters. TANGEDCO stated that this comprehensive system is not tried anywhere in India so far. The proposed cost of Rs.180.00 lakhs is for the procurement of equipment to carryout tests on live equipment and documentation of test results. Testing of Lightning arresters in 100 Nos of EHV/HV substations, identifying of suspicious arresters based on the test results and suggesting remedial action wherever necessary will be carried out in the 2nd & 3rd year.

The State Planning Commission recommended the project at an outlay of Rs.170.00 lakhs for the equipment cost under TANII and the documentation cost of Rs.10.00 lakhs to be met by TANGEDCO. The above scheme recommended for the year 2018-19 (Round-I) by the State Planning Commission for implementation is as follows:

4. The Government after careful consideration accord Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.170 lakhs (Rupees one hundred and seventy lakhs only) towards comprehensive condition monitoring techniques for lighting

arresters of EHV/HV substations using Third harmonic leakage current measurement, Infra Red Thermography in live conditions and off line HV watt loss test. The cost of Rs.10 Lakhs (Rupees ten Lakhs only) towards documentation charge for implementing the TANII LAS projects will be met from TANGEDCO's fund.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para (4) above shall be debitable under the following head of account:-
