ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the State Planning Commission has recommended for Installation of one Vending machine for sale of Khadi and Village Industries Products at a cost of Rs.20.00 Lakh under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes for the year 2018-2019.

2. In the letters second read above, the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board has stated that the Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board has been established on 01.04.1960 under the Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board Act, 1951 with an objective to improve the living standards of poor and downtrodden people living below poverty line, by launching and implementing various Khadi and village Industries schemes and also by coordinating with the agencies working for the rural development. The Board is implementing the Khadi schemes through 107 Rural Textile

centres, 47 Khadi production centres, 16 Khadi silk production centres and 84 Khadi sales centres. In addition to the above, under the Village Industries scheme, 16 Soap units, 13 Foot wear units, 7 Carpentry and Blacksimithy units, 1 Honey processing centre, 4 Handmade paper units, 2 Sambirani, agarabathi and allied products production centres and one Pottery unit are functioning under the control of the Board. If steps are taken to improve the marketability and sales of Khadi and Village products, their production can also be proportionately. This will also help the artisans and daily wage workers in rural areas to earn more and improve their livelihood. Though the Board is selling its products through Khadi Crafts, it is considered that a big boost in sale could be achieved by installing vending machine, which would attract not only the affluent class of customers but also would attract young boys and girls adding new entrants into the existing customer list. This would definitely increase the sale of Khadi products, the benefits of which can be passed on to the producers, such as rural labourers and village artisans.

Hence, by way of installing the Vending machine at important locations in Chennai, the sale of Khadi and Village Industries products can be increased, the products can be easily accessible by the public and also products can be more popularised amongst the general public.

- 3. The Chief Executive Officer Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board has therefore requested the government to sanction the fund to purchase one Vending machine for Sale of Khadi and Village Industries products under State Innovation Fund for Rs.20.00 lakh for the year 2018-19.
- 4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board sanction a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty lakh only) for purchase and installation of one Vending machine at Khadi Craft, Kuralagam, for sale of Khadi and Village Industries Products under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes for the year 2018-2019.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 4 above shall be met from the State Innovation Fund and debited to the following head of account:-

2851–00. Village and Small Industries – 105. Khadi and Village Industries – State's Expenditure –KI. Installation of Vending machine for sale of Khadi and Village Industries Products under – State Innovation Fund – 09. Grants-in-Aid-03. Grants for Specific Schemes.

- 8. Necessary additional funds Rs.20.00 lakh will be provided in RE/FMA/SI 2019-2020 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-4 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought for the notice of the Legislature by way of Specific inclusion of certain amount in the Supplementary Estimate 2019-2020. The Deputy Secretary to Government, Handlooms, Handicrafts, Textiles and Khadi Department is

directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE/FMA 2019-2020 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2019-2020 to Government in Finance (Ind./BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

- 9. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board is permitted to purchase one Vending machine for sale of Khadi and Village Industries Products as ordered in para-4 above and inform the action taken to the Government.
