# ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the State Planning Commission has, among others recommended for Establishment of Facilities for Identification of Intracranial Hematoma (Bleeding in Brain / Stroke) by near infrared based technology (non radiation technique) at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem.

2. Based on the above recommendation, the Mission Director, National Health Mission-Tamil Nadu has forwarded the proposals and request the Government

- i) to permit the Mission Director, National Health Mission Tamil Nadu to establish Facilities for Identification of Intracranial Hematoma (Bleeding in Brain / Stroke) by near infrared based technology (non radiation technique) at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives funds from the State Planning Commission with the specification approved by the committee constituted as per G.O. (Ms.) No.294, Health and amily Welfare Department, dated 26.09.2014.
- ii) to sanction an amount of Rs.150.00 lakhs towards procurement and supply of Near Infrared Based Detection Technology device to Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Government Mohan

Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.

3. The Government have examined the proposal in detail and permit the Mission Director, National Health Mission-Tamil Nadu to establish Facilities for Identification of Intracranial Hematoma (Bleeding in Brain / Stroke) by near infrared based technology (non radiation technique) at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives funds from the State Planning Commission for the year 2019-2020 (Round II) and sanction a sum of Rs.1,50,00,000/- lakh (Rs.One hundred and fifty lakh only) towards procurement and supply of Near Infrared Based Detection Technology device to Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Sovernment Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Innovation Technology device to Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Madurai and Facilitation Technology device to Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, Government Rajaji Medical College Hospital, Salem through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited and the detail is as follows :-
