ORDER :

In the reference first read above, the State Planning Commission has, among others recommended for Establishment of Centre of Excellence in Cardiovascular Imaging in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Institute of Cardiology, Chennai under TANII funds.

2. Based on the above recommendation, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has forwarded the proposals and request to the Government for Establishment of Centre of Excellence in Cardiovascular Imaging in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Institute of Cardiology, Chennai under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) funds and sanction an amount of Rs.3,64,20,000/towards procurement and supply of equipments thought Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation (TNMSC) for the year 2019-2020.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission in detail and permit the Mission Director, National Health Mission for Establishment of Centre of Excellence in Cardiovascular Imaging in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Institute of Cardiology, Chennai under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) funds and sanction an amount of Rs.285.00 lakhs (Rupees Two hundred and Eighty five lakh only) towards procurement and supply of equipment and sanction an amount of Rs.79.2 lakhs (Rupees Seventy nine lakh and twenty thousand only) towards procurement and supply of various catheters required for the Centre of excellence in Cardiology over a period of 3 years through Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation Limited the specification approved by the committee constituted as per G.O. (Ms.)No.294, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 26.09.2014. The details are as follows:
