ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for the establishment of "Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII)" in the State Planning Commission to promote Innovation in Government and Government Agencies. The "State Innovation Fund" in the State Planning Commission would finance new schemes if they are truly innovative in nature. Accordingly, every year there will be two or more rounds of sanction of financing from the "State Innovation Fund".

2. In the Government Order second and third read above, the Guidelines and procedures for Identification and Implementation of Innovative Schemes have been issued.

3. As per the norms prescribed in the above Government Orders, Government have forwarded the proposals received from the Director General, Highways Department in the letter fourth read above to the State Planning Commission for its approval at an estimated cost of Rs. 10.00 Lakhs under State Innovation Fund for the year 2019 -20 (Round – II).

4. The Member Secretary, State Planning Commission in his letter fifth read above has stated that, after detailed discussion, among others, the State Planning Commission has recommended the following proposal for implementation and forwarded to the Government:-

5. After careful examination, the Government accord administrative and financial sanction, for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) towards implementation of the scheme viz., Providing Sand Fencing along seashore at Dhanushkodi in NH 49 (Madurai – Dhanushkodi Road) under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2019 – 2020 by the Chief Engineer (H), National Highways, as detailed in para 4 above.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited under the following new Head of Account:-

“5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 01. National Highways – 337. Road works – State’s Expenditure – JC. Providing Sand Fencing along seashore at Dhanushkodi in NH 49 (Madurai – Dhanushkodi Road) – Scheme under State Innovation Fund – 416. Major works – 01. Major works”. [DPC 5054-01-337-JC-41601]

7. The above expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:

“5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 01. National Highways – 902. Deduct – Amount met from Reserve Fund – State’s Expenditure – AA. Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 330. Inter – Account Transfers – 01. Inter - Account Transfers.”

And Contra debiting the following fund account:

8. The Chief Engineer (H), National Highways is the Estimating, Reconciling and controlling authority for the above said new head of account.

9. Necessary Funds have been provided in second Supplementary Estimate 2019 - 2020. The Chief Engineer (H), National Highways is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para - 5 above. Further he/she has directed to restrict the expenditure strictly within the amount sanctioned in para 5above.
