ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued for the establishment of "Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII)" in the State Planning Commission to promote Innovation in Government and Government Agencies. The "State Innovation Fund" in the State Planning Commission would finance new schemes if they are truly innovative in nature. Accordingly, every year there will be two or more rounds of sanction of financing from the "State Innovation Fund".

- 2. In the Government Order second and third read above, the Guidelines and procedures for Identification and Implementation of Innovative Schemes, were issued.
- 3. As per the norms/guidelines prescribed in the above Government Orders, Government have forwarded the proposals received from the Director General, Highways Department in the letter fourth read above to the State Planning Commission for its approval at an estimated cost of Rs.5.00 Lakhs under State Innovation Fund for the year 2019 -20 (Round II).

4. The Member Secretary, State Planning Commission in his letter fifth read above has stated that, after detailed discussion, among others, the State Planning Commission has recommended the following proposal for implementation and forwarded to the Government as detailed below:-

- 2. In G.O.(D) No.14, Highways & Minor Ports (HN-1) Department, Dated 24.01.2020, the Government accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakh only) for implementing the scheme of "To study the effectiveness of curing compounds on concrete pavement" under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2019-20 by the Director, Highways Research station, Highways Department and also accord Financial Sanction for a sum of Rs.1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh only) for the year 2019-20 and the balance amount of Rs.4.00 lakh will be provided in the Financial year 2020-2021.
- 3. In the letter second read above, the Director, Highways Research Station, Highways Department has also stated that an amount of Rs.1.00 Lakh has been allotted for the year 2019-20 towards procurement of scientific equipment such as U Box, L Box, Concrete thermometer, Air Entrainmeter and Plastic cube moulds with

compressor. However, above items could not be delivered by the suppliers, though the supply order was issued, due to the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic National lockdown and hence the planned expenditure for an amount of Rs.1.00 lakhs could not made within the financial year 2019-20. However, out of Rs 4.00 lakhs allotted in 2nd year (2020-21), an expenditure of Rs 1.00 lakh has been made.

The Director, Highways Research Station, Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to allocate the total amount of Rs 5.00 lakhs for the year 2020-21 for the scheme of "Study of the effectiveness of curing compounds on Concrete Pavement work" along with the permission to utilize the above amount for necessary completion of the works during the financial year 2020-2021, since the work is now under progress and to be completed within this financial year an amount of Rs 1.00 lakh is required in addition to the allotted amount of Rs. 4.00 lakhs.
