As per the norms / guidelines prescribed in the above Government Orders, Government have forwarded the proposals received from the Managing Director, Metropolitan Transport Corporation (Chennai) Ltd., Chennai in the letter fourth read above to the State Planning Commission for its approval at an estimated cost of Rs.24,25,000/- under State Innovation Fund for the year 2019-20 (Round-II).
