ORDER:-

The Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) established in the State Planning Commission is to foster innovation through a variety of promotional activities and funding support to innovative ideas, schemes and programmes in Government agencies.

2. The State Planning Commission after detailed discussion has recommended the proposal of Installation of Electrical Incinerator in 100 Girls' Government High and Higher Secondary Schools submitted by School Education Department as follows:-

In both rural and urban areas, with increasing sanitation coverage in all schools, the disposal of waste is becoming a serious problem. Both biodegradable and non biodegradable waste can prove hazardous for health, if proper and complete disposal is not done. In schools especially, disposal of sanitary cloth and sanitary napkins in girls' toilets is big problem. It affects the proper functioning of the toilets when disposed in the toilet and serious health problems if thrown out in garbage dumps or in the open. The total project cost proposed is Rs.241.39 lakhs.

The State Planning Commission appraised the proposal in detail. The Electrical incinerator incinerates wastes like soiled cloth, cotton waste, sanitary napkins, paper towels etc. The waste gets converted into ash and other non-hazardous residues. The incinerator is user friendly and therefore suggested to do it in phases. The State Planning commission recommended the proposal as a pilot to be implemented in 100 schools with a reduced outlay of Rs.46.60 lakhs.

3. The Project Director, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan has stated that the Electrical incinerator incinerates wastes like soiled cloth, cotton waste, sanitary napkins, paper towels etc. The waste gets converted into ash and other non-hazardous residues. The Incineration chamber is made of Stainless Steel with Ash disposal from the bottom through ash scrapper. The heating in this Incinerator is done through Heating Elements which are designed to work on low watt density thus ensuring long life of heating elements and has requested to issues necessary administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.46.60 lakh to provide Electrical Incinerator for Girls Toilets in 100 schools.

4. The Government accept the proposal of Project Director, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.46.60 lakh (Rupees forty six lakh sixty thousand only) for the Installation of Electrical Incinerator for Girls Toilets in 100 Government Girls High and Higher Secondary Schools under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) under State Innovation Fund for the year 2016-17 as recommended by the State Planning Commission.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

6. The above expenditure shall be adjusted / met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

7. The Director of School Education is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the above new head of account – "2202-02-902-JC".

8. The Pay and Accounts Officers /Treasury Officers are directed to open the above new head of account in their books.
