



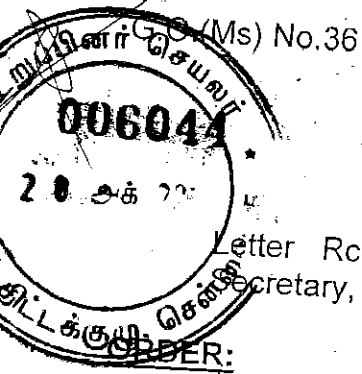

**ABSTRACT**

New Schemes under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2016-17 – Establishment of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu Sailing Academy and Centre of Excellence in sailing and rowing at Chennai – Sanction of Funds – Orders – Issued.

Letter Rc.No.15901/AOI/2014, dated 04.01.2016 from Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu.

In the letter first read above, the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has stated that in G.O.(Ms) No.345, Revenue (LD4) Department, dated 13.08.2014, the Government of Tamil Nadu had allotted 2.75 acres of land at prime location i.e. Marina Beach for establishing sailing academy and the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has also taken possession of the land on 03.11.2014. It is now proposed to establish Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu Sailing Academy and Centre of Excellence in Sailing and Rowing at the allotted site. The proposed facility would have the basic minimum facilities of international standards as required for training of sailors in disciplines, which are part of Olympic events.

2. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has further stated that the proposed academy would go a long way in identifying talented boys and girls. Training them in sailing will bring laurels not only to the State but to the Nation as a whole. The proposed site has a location advantage as it is abutting the Asia's longest beach i.e. "Marina" and the Chennai Port. It also has other advantages in terms of access to sea via Covum River mouth, required draft at landing site etc. The Tamil Nadu Sailing Association has also been consulted on designing the facilities at the academy. This proposal is for one time financial assistance for meeting out the non-recurring costs only. It is also clarified that the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu would mobilize the required funds for running the academy by levying user charges for the facilities / sponsorships and organizing events.

3. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary administrative and financial sanction under TANII for establishment of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu Sailing Academy and Centre of Excellence in Sailing and Rowing at a cost of Rs.22.76 crores at the earliest.

4. This scheme was also announced by Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 in Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 24.08.2016.

5. The Government after careful consideration, sanction a sum of Rs.7,00,00,000/- (Rupees Seven crores only) as non-recurring grant for establishment of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu Sailing Academy and Centre of Excellence in Sailing and Rowing at Chennai, with basic minimum facilities under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative Schemes (TANII) 2016-17.

6. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is requested to make a feasibility study on environmental issues with funding from TNIDB and Government of India part funding.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited under the following head of account.

"2204-00 Sports and Youth services – 104 Sports and Games – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan-II. State Plan – KX SDAT Sailing Academy, Centre of Excellence in Sailing and Rowing at Chennai – Schemes under State Innovation Fund – 09. Grants-in-Aid – 02 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets."

8. The above expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account.

"2204 – 00 Sports and Youth Services – 902 Deduct – Amount from State Innovation Fund – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan – II. State Plan - JB Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 30 Inter Accounts Transfers."

And contra debiting J Reserve Fund (b) Reserve Funds not bearing interest – 8229 00 Development and Welfare Funds – 200 Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund.

9. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu shall prepare the bill and present it to the Pay and Accounts Officer, Secretariat, Chennai-9 through the Under Secretary to Government, Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department. The amount sanctioned above shall not be paid in cash but shall be credited into following head of account by means of cheque.

"K. Deposits and Advances – (B) Deposits not bearing Interest – 8443 – 00 Civil Deposits – 800 Other Deposits – CH Deposits of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu" (DPC 8443 00 800 CH 000D) " by means of a cheque / demand draft drawn in favour of Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu P.D. A/C No.6184513932.

10. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu shall send the detailed expenditure report, utilization certificate etc., to Government at the appropriate time.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.47419/Edn.I/2016, dated 22.09.2016.
