From the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps, Chennai, Letter No.1456/SC/TANII, dated 31.3.2017.

In the letter read above, the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has stated that the Naval Wing Cadets are able to fulfill their dream by the waterman ship activities for cadets such as sailing expeditions, rowing, yatching etc., conducted by the Indian Navy at INS Chikra every year. Presently boats held with the units are very few in number and maintenance is also huge. The sculling simulator with the outriggers and oars makes sure that the exact muscles and movements used in rowing are being utilized. It is also ideal for instruction, rehearsing hand movement essential for rowing. He has therefore requested for installing a rowing simulator for training at 5 Naval wing units in National Cadet Corps at the cost of Rs.30 lakhs under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII).

- 2. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has therefore requested the Government to acquire financial sanction under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for installation of Rowing Simulator to enhance the National Cadet Corps Cadets quality of training prior to actual handling of boat at 5 Naval wing units under the control of National Cadet Corps Directorate for a sum of Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty Lakhs only) at the earliest.
- 3. The Government after careful examination sanction a sum of Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty Lakhs only) as non-recurring expenditure to the National Cadet Corps Directorate towards the installation of Rowing Simulator to enhance the National Cadet Corps Cadets quality of training prior to their actual handling of boat at 5 Naval wing units of National Cadet Corps Directorate under Tamil Nadu Innovative Initiatives for the year 2017-18.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the following Head of account:

5. The above expenditure shall be met from State Innovation Fund by deduction under the following head of account:

- 6. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account.
- 7. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps shall send the detailed expenditure report, utilization certificate etc., to the Government at the appropriate time.
